- According to a Texas Education Agency's report, in the 2019-2020 school year, 84% of Texas public high school students took at least one math course beyond Algebra II, while 56% of students pursued at least one science course beyond biology. These statistics underscore educators' focus on advancing STEM education.
- Texas ISDs are home to many STEM-focused schools and academies that provide specialized learning environments to empower and cultivate the potential of students interested in STEM disciplines.
- Texas ISDs offer various STEM-focused professional development opportunities for teachers. By investing in the growth and expertise of educators, ISDs strengthen their educational foundation and ensure students receive highquality STEM instruction.
- According to the National Science Foundation, in 2020, Texas ranked third in the country for the number of bachelor's degrees awarded in science and engineering fields, trailing behind only California and New York. Texas Public Schools

produce a significant number of skilled STEM graduates.

• The demand for workers with STEM skills in Texas's economy remains high. The Texas Workforce Commission projects that STEM-related occupations will experience faster growth than non-STEM occupations over the next decade. Additionally, STEM careers tend to offer higher wages, making them a pathway to economic prosperity.
